After that we went back to school on the bus.

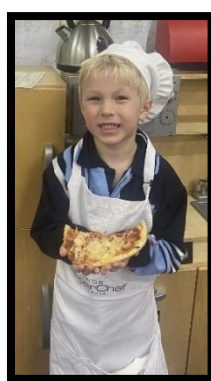
We sang happy birthday to Max and then had lunch with birthday cupcakes (they were yum). It was a fun day.
